UPCOMING MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES:

January 2, 2018: Andrea Warren - *Golden's Watermedia*

Andrea Warren is an Ottawa visual artist and educator and Working Artist for *Golden Artist Colors*. Andrea received her degree in visual arts and philosophy from Trinity Western University in Langley, BC, and has been featured in publications such as *Ottawa Life*, *Create!*, and *Art Ascent* magazines. Andrea will talk about Golden's 'Watermedia' including High Flow Acrylics, Fluid Acrylics, and QoR Watercolour. Learn new techniques in both watercolour and acrylic, like staining, pouring, washes, layering, blooms, 'white-out' tricks. Explore unique substrates such as wood panel, fabrics, plastics and more, and options for protecting your watercolour surfaces without putting them behind glass, using Golden archival varnishes. Don't miss the fun!

February 6, 2018: Holly Dean - *Marketing Your Art*

Holly affirms: "I believe we all have a strong, basic need to explore and create. When we give ourselves permission to play, to be child-like again, we discover who we are. Magic is invited in." Holly will talk about how to promote your art – building a website, what to include, driving traffic to your website through social media, and much more. 'Taking your art to the next level....' March 6, 2018: Jacky MacDonald - *Palette Knife Demo & Elements of Good Composition*

Local artist and former MAA member, Jacky MacDonald will give a demonstration using the palette knife, while also discussing the elements of good composition. Jacky moved to Europe as a teenager, studying the works of the Great Masters on display in the museums of Paris, Amsterdam, Berlin and Madrid. She studied fashion design with Richard Robinson, taught at Algonquin College and the

Ottawa Board of Education. In 2015 Jacky's design, The Autumn Express, was chosen by the Royal Canadian Mint for the \$20 silver coin. Jacky's paintings have been on display at a number of Canadian Galleries, including [Koyman Galleries](#) in Ottawa.
